DUTY OF CARE EXPECTATIONS & PROCEDURES

PROCEDURES FOR STUDENTS:

- Bring your school bag with ONLY lunchbox & water bottle.
- Always be considerate when walking around the finish line and be aware of other events.

Students <u>CAN</u> leave the bay if they're going to...

- · their event
- use the toilet (need a pass)
- Lunch with their OWN
 parents/carers (sign out
 with their classroom teacher)

Students <u>CAN'T</u> leave the bay...

- at Recess (parents may visit the bay to bring treats/food)
- · to buy food
- to visit their parents/carers

EXPECTATIONS FOR PARENTS/CARERS:

- When events commence, please remain in the parent viewing areas.
- Encourage all students in a positive manner.
- <u>Kindy and Pre-Primary parents/carers:</u> if you choose to take your child out of class for the remainder of the day to attend siblings' events, please notify their classroom teacher and sign them out on the day.

These students are no longer under the duty of care of the school but under the parents' duty of care.



TEACHERS DUTY OF CARE:

- Teachers must wear a high visibility vest.
- Toilet Passes: ensure students go to the toilet with another student.
- A designated teacher will collect and return the toilet passes.

CONCLUSION OF THE CARNIVAL:

- Students remain in their bay until collected by their classroom teacher.
- Classes will walk back to school and gather in their classroom.
- Students may go home with their parents, MUST SIGN OUT with their classroom teacher.
- In the case of a distressed student with additional needs, the student may be walked back to school early with a
 CPS staff member. At school they will be supervised by an Education Assistant until the conclusion of the carnival.
